Specific – WHO? WHAT?

GI has a goal of encouraging cross-disciplinary networking and knowledge exchange

Measurement/Assessment – HOW?

In order to achieve cross-disciplinary and networking meetings, the GI board, will use their collective networks to find other interested groups and will provide suggestions to the Program Chair, for tallying, discussion and selection by the 2nd GI board meeting of the Program Year, typically in September. The GI Chairperson will also reach out to the other groups to see if they have any suggested lecturers or lecture topics for the current program year. Once a short list of lecturers has been created, the GI board, with input from the other group, will select at least 2 lecturers and lecture topics.

Attainable/Achieve – REASONABLE?

The Program Chairperson will make the necessary arrangements with the cooperating society or group to secure details regarding dates; venues; speakers; and registration.

Relevant – EXPECTED RESULT?

The expected result is to conduct at least two (one Fall, one Spring) joint lecture meetings with another engineering society or another Pittsburgh ASCE Institute. Other geologic societies currently included are: AEG; PGS; DFI.

Timed – WHEN?

This goal will be implemented for at least the next three years through fiscal year 2017-2018.
